#1: Faith & Finances

led by: Mark Brown, National Lead Faith & Finances Trainer

This curriculum is designed to help your affiliate work specifically with low-income adults. Add Faith & Finances to your Transformational Ministry Program to address the challenges the materially poor face and help them rediscover their God-given dignity.

This two-part facilitator training includes: four weeks of online training prior to the live training at the Gathering.

#2: Work Life

led by: Sean Landolt, The Chalmers Center

Helping people find and keep meaningful work is one of the best ways to address the root causes of poverty. Work Life is a soft job-skills training program for people who are unemployed or underemployed. The program empowers participants with the skills, character, and relationships to find work - and flourish in it. At the facilitator training course, you'll gain the skills and confidence to start a Work Life class in your affiliate!

The training begins with four weeks of online learning with other participants, three days of training integrated with Love INC's National Gathering, a copy of the Work Life Facilitator and Participant Guides, and hands-on practice using the curriculum with feedback from your peers.





#3: Affirming Potential

led by: Lois Tupyi & Renee Howe, Love INC of Treasure Valley

This training will prepare your affiliate to provide Affirming Potential as a Transformational Ministry Class. Affirming Potential is a twelve-week class that explores the physical, emotional, relational, and spiritual areas of a person's life from a biblical perspective. The AP Dream Tool will help participants set and achieve goals and action steps to help them achieve their full potential. Affirming Potential is an unique offering by Love INC of Treasure Valley and endorsed by Love INC National.

#4: Leadership Development

led by: Dr. Christina Edmondson, Calvin College

This track will explore the qualities and activities of a biblical transformational leader based on the ministry of Nehemiah and the example of Jesus. Sessions will include the difference between transactional leaders and transformational leaders, the critical importance of godly virtue, the power of godly transforming vision, aligning volunteers and leading as a faithful steward. This track will guide participants to evaluate and improve their own leadership, and offer practical suggestions for leading effectively in a uniquely Love INC context.

#5: Peacemaker

led by: Brian Noble and Anne Bachle Fifer, Peacemaker Ministries

The work of Love INC is not immune to conflict: Between staff, within boards, with volunteers, and relationships with churches. It is a matter of when not if, right?

Navigating through conflict is important to do well. It isn't everyone's favorite topic, but be proactive and equip yourself. In this track, you will learn a three-dimensional response to conflict that is biblical, practical, and effective.

Peacemaker Ministries has a proven track record in equipping people in conflict resolution, and will be delivering a new resource called, The Path of a Peacemaker. In this engaging, interactive two-day course, you





will not just study biblical principles and learn how to apply them, you'll discuss and practice them in role plays.

You will emerge with solid foundational skills to be a peacemaker.

#6: Redemptive Compassion®

led by: Shelley Zimmerman, Love INC of Newaygo

Redemptive Compassion® is a biblical philosophy on how we can offer holistic help to those we serve. It challenges many current and common ways of addressing need based on its six core principles.

- So how do we help our churches understand and embrace this philosophy?
- What might it look like to walk alongside our churches through this training process?

In this track, we will walk through the facilitation of the Redemptive Compassion study together and discuss ways to better engage our churches.

#7: Love INC Core for All

In the 1960 Super Bowl, the Green Bay Packers suffered a crushing loss to the Philadelphia Eagles. Green Bay's iconic coach, Vince Lombardi, started next year's training camp methodically covering the fundamentals of football to seasoned professional athletes and continued throughout training camp. Just one year later, the Packers won the Super Bowl.

This track is relevant to everyone; those just beginning or long-timers. Are we who we say we are to each other and the communities we serve?

Topics include: missional integrity, core values, ministry modes, church relationships, community connections, Redemptive Compassion®, board responsibilities, Love INC resources, and more.

#8: Marketing & Communications

led by: Love INC Metro Tampa Team

How high impact is your affiliate's messaging, media storytelling, and fundraising?

Love INC of Metro Tampa (www.loveinctampa.org) will share their "best practices" in two hands-on sessions presented by communications, training, and media expert, Darlene Coker (www.organiclearn.com) and cofounders, Ann and Michael Doyle.

Utilizing a two-track workshop format, Messaging, Media, and Promotion & Storytelling and Fundraising, allows participants to self-assess current practices, share best/most-effective practices, discover new



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concepts, skills, and techniques, and develop initial products to take home. It is recommended that participants attend as an affiliate team to maximize workshop impact.
